General (Adult) Student VISA LETTER

Student information

Koji Takano of Japanese nationality has enrolled at this centre and is applying for an Adult Student visa. The student's passport number is P0987G1234H and his date of birth is 20 August 1983.

Centre information

This centre is accredited by Accreditation UK and is listed on the UK Border Agency Register of Sponsors with sponsor number A1B23C45DE

Course information

Koji Takano has enrolled with us on an English Language Course leading to an English Language Certificate at Level B2 of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages. The course starts on 15 August 2009 with an induction period and ingoing assessment and the student has booked for 6 months, so the expected end date is 15 February 2010. There will be 20 hours of organised study per week.

In our professional judgement the student is able to follow the course successfully based on the evidence of his present competence in English which we have seen, namely (*INSERT evidence used to assess the migrant's ability to finish the course, e.g. level or type of qualification and awarding body or institution*).

Financial information

The total cost of the course tuition is £2,000.
The student has paid £1,500 of these fees in advance.

The student therefore needs to prove to you that he has available to him funds equivalent to:

- £2,000 minus £1,500 for his course fees already paid.
- £3,600 for living costs based upon 6 months stay in Example Town.

By my calculation, this means the student should provide you with proof of funds of the equivalent of £4,100.
