

## Race Relations Act 1976

### SECTION 19D MINISTERIAL AUTHORISATION

#### Race Relations (Immigration and Asylum) (Employment under the Sectors-Based Scheme) Authorisation 2003

Made	May 2003
Coming into operation	30 <sup>th</sup> May 2003

I make the following authorisation under section 19D (3) (a) of the Race Relations Act 1976<sup>a</sup>:

1. This authorisation may be cited as the Race Relations (Immigration and Asylum) (Employment under the Sectors-Based Scheme) Authorisation 2003, and shall come into operation on 30<sup>th</sup> May 2003.
2. In this Authorisation –

“immigration rules” means the rules for the time being laid down under section 3(2) of the Immigration Act 1971<sup>b</sup>; and  
“Sectors-Based Scheme” means a scheme operated by the Secretary of State under the immigration rules for persons seeking to enter the United Kingdom to take specified employment in specified sectors.

3. In operating the Sectors-based Scheme, the Secretary of State may specify that, of the total number of immigration employment documents which are available for issue under it in any given period, a proportion will be available for issue only to those who may apply on behalf of citizens or nationals of the countries listed in the Schedule to this Authorisation.
