

**EMPLOYMENT OUTSIDE THE RULES**

**REFUSAL FORMULAE**

**PLEASE NOTE:** *The following wordings are examples - they do not constitute an exhaustive list of all possible formulae.*

*The following wordings may be used as appropriate for any of the categories contained in Chapter 17.*

**ON ENTRY**

"You have asked for leave to enter the United Kingdom as a .... for....."

**No valid work permit**

"... but this is employment for which a work permit is required and I am not satisfied that you hold a valid Department for Education and Employment work permit"

**Paragraph 130 with reference to Paragraph 128(i)**

*\* No entitlement to appeal by virtue of Section 13(3B)(a)*

{Refusal Code: B1}

**Intention to leave**

"... but I am not satisfied that you intend to leave the United Kingdom at the end of the period of your visit/employment."

**Paragraph 130 with reference to 128(vi)**

{Refusal Code: B3}

**AFTER ENTRY**

"You have applied for leave to remain in the United Kingdom as ... for..."

**No switching**

"... but this is employment for which a work permit is required and the Secretary of State is not satisfied that you entered the United Kingdom with a valid Department for Education and Employment work permit."

*\* No entitlement to appeal by virtue of Section 14(2A)(a)*

{INDECS Code: W7}

**Maximum 6 months**

"... but [? in view of...] the Secretary of State is not satisfied that you have not already spent more than 6 months in total in the United Kingdom as a visitor.

**Paragraph 46 with reference to 44 (ii)**

*\* No entitlement to appeal by virtue of Section 14(2A)(c)*

{INDECS Code: A5}

**AFTER ENTRY - REFUSAL OF INDEFINITE LEAVE TO REMAIN**

"You have applied for indefinite leave to remain in the United Kingdom as ..."

**Not 4 years in category**

"... but [? in view of ...] the Secretary of State is not satisfied that you have spent a continuous period of 4 years in the United Kingdom in a capacity that leads to settlement."

**Paragraph 135 with reference to 134(i)**

{INDECS Code: X7}

**Still required**

"... but [? in view of ...] the Secretary of State is not satisfied that your employer has certified that you are still required for the employment in question.

**Paragraph 135 with reference to 134(iii)**

{INDECS Code: W6}

---

**ENTRY CLEARANCE**

"You have applied for entry clearance to the United Kingdom to as ..."

**No work permit**

"... but this is employment for which a work permit is required and the Secretary of State is not satisfied that you hold a valid Department for Education and Employment work permit."

**Paragraph 130 with reference to 128(i)**

*\* No entitlement to appeal by virtue of Section 13(3B)(a)*

**Intention to leave**

"... but [? in view of ...] the Secretary of State is not satisfied that you intend to leave the United Kingdom at the end of your visit/employment."
