UNITED KINGDOM ANCESTRY

REFUSAL FORMULAE

PLEASE NOTE: The following wordings are examples - they do not constitute an exhaustive list of all possible formulae.

ON ENTRY

"You have asked for leave to enter the United Kingdom on the grounds of United Kingdom ancestry..."

No entry clearance - non-visa national

"but under the Immigration Rules you are required to have a valid entry clearance for this purpose and you have no such entry clearance."

Paragraph 186 (vi)

**** No entitlement to appeal by virtue of Section 13(3B)(a)***

{Refusal Code: E4}

Visa national

"... but under the Immigration Rules you are required to produce a passport or other identity document endorsed with a valid and current United Kingdom entry clearance issued for the purpose for which entry is sought, and you have no such entry clearance."

**** No entitlement to appeal by virtue of Section 13(3B)(a)***

{Refusal Code: E4}

AFTER ENTRY

"You have applied for leave to remain in the United Kingdom on the grounds of United Kingdom ancestry..."

Non-Commonwealth citizen

"...but you are a national of... and consequently the Secretary of State is not satisfied that you are a Commonwealth citizen."

** No entitlement to appeal by virtue of Section 14(2A)(b)*

Under age

"...but as you were born on.... the Secretary of State is not satisfied that you are aged 17 or over."

"... but you have been unable to provide proof that one of your grandparents was born in the United Kingdom and Islands."

Ability to work

INDEFINITE LEAVE TO REMAIN

"You have applied for indefinite leave to remain in the United Kingdom on the grounds of United Kingdom ancestry..."

Non-Commonwealth citizen

"... but you are a national of... and consequently the Secretary of State is not satisfied that you are a Commonwealth citizen."

** No entitlement to appeal by virtue of Section 14(2A)(b)*

Under age

Ability to work

Intention to work

"...but [? in view of...] the Secretary of State is not satisfied that you intend to take or seek employment in the United Kingdom."

Maintenance and accommodation

Not 4 years in category

"...but [? in view of...] the Secretary of State is not satisfied that you have spent a continuous period of 4 years in the United Kingdom in this capacity."

ENTRY CLEARANCE

"You have applied for entry clearance to the United Kingdom on the grounds of United Kingdom ancestry..."

Non-Commonwealth citizen

"...but you are a national of ... and consequently the Secretary of State is not satisfied that you are a Commonwealth citizen."

Under age
