



Group Travel



What is Group Travel?

Group Travel is a separate area in the Immigration Arrivals Hall of major ports in the United Kingdom where passengers arriving as part of a group, or intending to join a group may clear immigration quickly.

Who can use Group Travel?

You can use Group Travel if:

- You are arriving as part of a group, or intending to join a group in the UK, for example a tour group, school or student group, sports team, or group of conference delegates.
- You do not intend to stay in the UK for more than 6 months.

What do I do on arrival?

- You should complete a landing card prior to arrival in the UK.
- You should remain with your group, if possible.
- You should follow signs in the Immigration Arrivals Hall to **GROUP TRAVEL** where your entry to the UK will be processed.
- If you hold an invitation card/information leaflet you should give this to the Immigration Officer.
- If the Group Leader is accompanying the group, he/she should present the group to the Immigration Officer.
